
Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code § 551, that the Board of Directors of Belvedere Municipal Utility District of Travis County will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on Thursday, May 25, 2017 at 6:00 p.m., within the boundaries of the District, at The Belvedere Amenity Center, 17400 Flagler Drive, Austin, Texas, for the following purposes:

1. Discuss, consider and take action to approve the minutes of the April 18, 2017 regular meeting and May 7, 2017 special meeting;
2. Receive public comment;
3. Discuss, consider and take action on application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on Bond Issue No. 4 regarding recreational facilities, including but not limited to:
 1. Consideration and action on Bond Anticipation Note (BAN);
4. Discuss, consider and take action as necessary concerning report from the District's Bookkeeper, including but not limited to, payment of invoices;
5. Discuss, consider and take action on existing and future budget issues;
6. Discuss, consider and take action to solicit proposals for District Engineer;
7. Discuss, consider and take action regarding a report from the District's Engineer including drainage issues within the District, trail system maintenance and pond liner rehabilitation;
8. Discuss, consider and take action as necessary concerning potential District acquisition of road powers;
9. Discuss, consider and take action as necessary concerning property and facilities owned and maintained within the District, including:
 - a. Joint maintenance agreement between the Belvedere Homeowners' Association and the District; and
10. Adjournment.

The District may meet in executive session on any item listed above as provided by the Open Meetings Act, Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 551.071, 551.072, 551.073, 551.074, or 551.075.
